Hey everybody! Thanks for signing up for the Poca Go! 2022 Kids Race!

This message contains a lot of info- so please read it in it's entirety. The race is tomorrow (Saturday, June 18th) with check-in starting at 9:30am and the first race beginning at 10:00. I'm attaching a start list with approximate* start times (all times subject to change depending on how long each race takes and if there are additional sign-ups etc).

Check-in and Parking

Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before your designated start time. Proceed to the check-in table to pick up your bib number and race sticker. Check-in will be at the far end of the Courthouse parking lot (look for the Pello tent). To get to this parking lot use GPS address: 7298 Courthouse Rd Chesterfield, VA 23832. Please note: parking in this lot is limited. It is best if you can carpool or, for older racers, please consider parking at the pool parking lot within the main park (off State Park Rd) and ride the 1.5 miles up to the Swift Creek trails.

What to Bring

Be sure to bring: helmet, water/hydration, snack, sunscreen, bugspray

Rules

Every racer must be accompanied by an adult. Helmets are required. For the younger racers (4 and under); an adult may stay on course with the child- as long as they stay back and to the side- as to not interfere with any other racers. Racers should always be given the right of way. Please inform your child of trail etiquette: ride to the right side of the trail. Pass on the left. Announce yourself if you'd like to pass (shout: Passing on your left!). Be a good sport! Each heat/race will have a maximum of 6-7 racers as to minimize trail congestion and passing, etc.

Course Descriptions

All races will begin on the fireroad near the Courthouse parking lot.

2-year-old balance bike: A flat, out-and-back on the fireroad. Begin near the parking lot. Turn-around will be near the Gateway trail entrances. Total distance: approximately 0.25 miles

3-year-old balance bike/4-5-year-old pedal bikes: A mix of fireroad and beginner trail. Begin near the parking lot. Proceed down the fireroad and enter the trail at Gateway 1 (veer left). Ride a full loop of Gateway 1, turning a right at the exit to proceed back onto the fireroad. Finish near Courthouse parking lot. Total distance: approximately 0.75 miles.

6–10-year-old pedal bikes: A mix of fireroad and beginner trail. Begin near the parking lot. Proceed down the fireroad and enter the trail at Gateway 1 (veer left). Ride a full loop of Gateway 1 and then proceed across the fireroad to enter Gateway 2. Ride a full loop of Gateway 2 and at the exit, veer right to proceed back onto the fireroad heading to the finish line/parking lot. Total distance: approximately 1.25 miles.

Categories and Heats

Each race/heat will have a maximum of 6-7 racers. All racers in each heat will begin at the same time. There will be a small gap between each heat. Finish place is determined by order of finish.
